As part of the Feather River Land Trust stewardship crew, you will be improving and maintaining public access, performing vegetation management and developing teamwork and leadership skills. Our goal is to hire one intern from Loyalton and one intern from Portola to work with our stewardship crew on the Sierra Valley Preserve.

DATES: June 21 - August 18, 2021

This is a 9-week program working three to four 7 ½ or 8-hour days per week.

SALARY: \$15.00 per hour (summer earnings of \$3,600-4,800)

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a high school student at either Loyalton or Portola High Schools
- Must be 16-18 years old.
- Must have a Social Security card or have applied for one.
- Must have a driver's license and vehicle at time of hire.
- Must be willing to work in a variety of conditions heat, cold and working in and around water, and be able to lift at least 25lbs.
- Have a work permit in place at time of hire. You can coordinate with your local school to obtain one.
- Must be available to work at least 7 of the 9 weeks.
