Summer Youth Internship Program

FRLT is seeking **two** highly-motivated and energetic high school students, ages 16 to 18, who enjoy working outdoors engaged in a variety of field-oriented tasks.

As a member of the FRLT Stewardship Team, you will be working to improve and maintain public access and manage vegetation alongside local resource management experts and mentors, while deepening your understanding of the natural and cultural history of the Sierra Valley. We are looking to hire one student from the Loyalton area and one student from the Portola area to assist our Stewardship Team on the Sierra Valley Preserve for Summer 2022.

**When:** Internship Program runs **June 20 through August 14, 2022**. This 8-week program will require a commitment of three to five days per week, consisting of 7.5-8 hour workdays. The actual work schedule will vary depending on the job assignment.

**Salary:** \$15.00 per hour (estimated summer earnings of \$3,600-\$4,800).

### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school student enrolled at either Loyalton or Portola area high schools
- 16-18 years old
- Valid work permit in place at time of hire (you can coordinate with your school to obtain one!)
- Valid social security card
- Valid driver's license
- Reliable transport to and from job site
- Willingness to work in varied environmental conditions (heat, cold, working in & around water)
- Ability to lift at least 35lbs
- *Availability to commit to working at least 7 of the 8 program weeks*
